Features & Improvements

Presenter and Moderator View

New views have been tailored to the existing Participant role, and an additional role called Moderator has been added.

The Moderator view of the Control Panel includes the live view of the Broadcast and the ability to moderate the Q&A. Moderators can access the moderator view by an external link and will have the same options as in the AI Producer Control Panel in Teams. Moderators can publish questions and include notes for Presenters to see.

Access to the page can be protected with either Microsoft 365 Single Sign-On, password protection, or no protection.

Users assigned the Participant role have a different view of the Control Panel and can see whether a Moderator or Producer has added a note to a published question. Presenters can claim their own question, indicating to other users that they will respond to the question. The presenter's view is also available as an external page with the protection options Microsoft 365 Single Sign-On, password protection, or no protection.

Please note: To use Microsoft Single Sign-On, AI Producers must be accessible from the user's tenant.

Dedicated Q&A Section in the Control Panel for Producers

All Q&A features are now grouped in a dedicated Q&A section on the main page of the Control Panel for Producers. This update provides a more organized workspace and allows Producers to manage audience interactions more efficiently.

Destination Status

Producers are now kept informed of the starting status between AI Producer and their selected destination, making it easier to detect any errors or failures when starting a Broadcast and providing better control over delivery.



Manage On-Screen Presenters

Non-selected Presenters can now be managed from the Control Room and Control Panel, giving Producers the ability to easily add them to be part of the Broadcast.

More Than One Teacher

Education Mode now supports up to four teachers who can be selected and displayed in a recording.
