## Features & Improvements

### Reuse Sessions for Recurring Meetings

Producers can now reuse the same Teams meeting for recurring AI Producer Sessions. After ending a session, the *Reuse Button* allows producers to prepare and start a new AI Producer Session in the same meeting, creating a separate recording and Q&A transcript for each run. This feature is supported across all formats.

### UI Updates to Ad Hoc Videos

The ad hoc play video experience in the Control Room has been updated so videos are listed in the carousel in the order they are selected, and the full name of the active video is shown with the progress bar. Playback controls now also include hover tooltips for Start, Pause, Stop, and Loop.

### Improved Presenter Status Tracking

Presenter status is now consistently tracked and displayed for all participants during a production, indicating whether the camera is on, off, or the user is no longer in the Teams meeting. The legacy participant status under Troubleshoot has been removed.

### OneDrive Improvements

Original OneDrive recordings now appear faster in the User Portal. OneDrive files now also use a clearer date-based naming pattern, for example, *Q2-Report-July01-2024.mp4*.

In addition to these features and improvements, some minor enhancements have been made, and a few bugs have been fixed.
